#### Appendix 1

BMC Proposed Talent Development Strategy 2016 - 2021 Last year, the BMC began reviewing their current talent development programme with consideration to how the organisation could change its approach in the future. Kelvyn and others were very generous with their time in attending a meeting in December hosted by the BMC and sharing their ideas. The BMC volunteer team managers also considered the issue at one of their recent meetings. Downloadable HERE (you'll need to be logged in to download) is a brief document outlining a different approach the BMC could take, and Jon Garside (jon@thebmc.co.uk) would welcome your views. Working backwards, the ultimate deadline to agree upon the BMC's direction regarding talent development is spring 2016, when the BMC will begin the process of submitting a funding bid to Sport England to cover the 2017 – 2021 period. But in reality, the next six months is the period in which the future direction taken by the BMC needs to be identified and the all-important detail (which is not in the attached document) figured out. Working on the assumption that we all want the same thing, namely a system that will we believe will effect change in supporting talented young climbers, then please do let Jon know your views. Any plan will only be truly effective if the BMC and partner organisations, including the ABC, are able to work together in delivering it, therefore views from as many different perspectives are essential. Jon is asking you to provide your feedback by Friday 31 **July** at the very latest.
