Dovestones. No progress yet re the notice at base of crag – no climbing & trespassers will be prosecuted. Open Access land. Rob Dyer to help investigate.

Bridestones. Drill holes noted - speculated to be either by cavers practising SRT or possibly associated with motorbike trials race flag positions, but should now have been filled in.

Moughton Nab. Advised to access from the south rather than past Foredale

Youth. Very successful YCS with biggest turnout ever. Third place overall in final.

Climbing walls. Clip 'n Climb wall opened in Ilkley. New climbing wall opening in Huddersfield. New bouldering wall opening in Leeds.

Clubs. Noted that the Clubs Committee has developed a discussion document re integrating clubs into achieving the BMC objectives – intended to link in with the BMC's Strategic Plan.
