Minutes

1. Welcome and apologies

2. Minutes of the previous meeting

The meeting agreed that the minutes were an accurate record.

3. Actions from the previous meeting

5. Access and conservation briefing

- a. The Mend Our Mountains footpath repair campaign was successful in reaching its £100,000 target; when the crowdfunding campaign closed on 16 May we had raised £103,832.
- b. Concerns had been raised over access to Neath Abbey; current advice is to be discreet and use the approach advised by the local climbers to avoid any confrontation.
- c. Peregrines are nesting in the cave part way up East Gully Groove at Paviland. Please avoid this route/area until they have fledged.

6. Wales Area Update

- a. Pembroke Range West briefings have been well attended, with 90+ at the last meeting; most were climbers. The MOD reminded everyone that all climbers must obey all the access rules and "access is a privilege not a right."
- b. The BMC has submitted a response to the Glyn Rhonwy pumped storage scheme in North Wales listing various concerns including the destruction of the first ever recorded routes on the slate.
