Comment

3 reports were received from CC&G of climbing outside the allowed season. 16 March on Horseshoe Bend, 30 April -High Rock, 9 May -Knights Climb. Total 6 climbers
 21 climbers were climbing on the CC&G side either out of season - 10, or uninsured -11. All agreed eadilly to move to the NT side. 1 Bought insurance showed me confirmation email from BMC.
 Of the 436 climbers recorded in the gorge, 328 were climbing on the National trust side and 108 on the Longleat side.
 All but 9 were on sport routes, although 1 group on Stepped wall were intending to climb on trad routes.
 Bolt hangers were removed from Pigs Hole, Ginsberg Wall, Horseshoe, High Rock and Wind Rock on the 3rd July
 2 passes up the gorge were made on each of the August Bank Holidays, few climbers were seen, none on the CC&G side. All bolt hangers were replaced on the 29th August.
 Just over half of recorded climbers were either BMC or affiliated club members. 82 were not. Of the 122 for whom a response was not gained,most were on the NT side .
 Almost all climbers on the CC&G side were asked and responded. However some were out of reach on multi pitch routes.
