#### **Clubs.**

AW reported that there has been much discussion concerning the BMC Participation statement and safeguarding issues. It has been difficult to network with other local clubs and gain insights into their views. AW noted that it had been quite a frustrating year on Clubs Committee, but a new chair had just been appointed and we were looking forward to a higher drive and output. JW noted that a lot of work goes on behind the scenes to support clubs, such as support with child protection matters and work to support a family and club and influence a coroner dealing with a death on a club meet. If clubs have issues, there are usually either other clubs or specialists that we can call on for support.

In discussion issues were raised concerning etiquette at crags - recent concerns about dirty rock shoes and climbing on wet vulnerable rock at crags. From this final point it was agreed that the solution to these issues lies in engaging all local clubs including University Clubs. The new members of the committee were recognised as better placed to reach in particular the student clubs and other young climbers, and were encouraged to do so. Members noted that some might not have been made aware of local ethics, particular following the skills fade in student clubs due to covid where knowledge normally handed down might have been

missed. EF asked whether a talk on local environmental etiquette at a future meeting would be useful – all agreed that it would be.

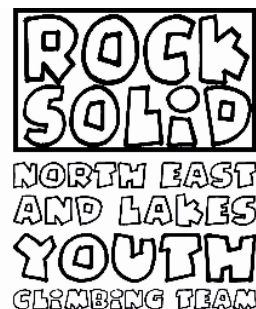

### Youth Report

#### Youth Climbing Series.

The Grand Final of the 2023 Youth Climbing Series took place last weekend at the Parthian Climbing Centre, Southampton. The event was extremely successful, having been very well organised and run. Climbers from the Northeast and Lakes who had qualified to compete, all did the region proud with some exceptional displays of climbing in a competition which as expected was of a very high standard.

#### Regional Training Days.

Climb Scotland the Youth section of MCoS have been approached, with a view to allowing Rock Solid to join in with their program of youth training which we hope will benefit both organisations and continue our long standing cross boarder relationship.

#### Rock Solid Inter Wall Trophy 2024.

16<sup>th</sup> March is the proposed date for the inaugural Rock Solid Inter-Wall Trophy

This is a new competition in which we are inviting climbing walls from around the Northeast and Lakes to submit a team of eight climbers, four under 16's and four under 12's. Individual 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals will be presented for each age category, but this is a team competition. Team scores will be added together, and the winning climbing wall receives the trophy and bragging rites for the next twelve months.

Rock Solid has commissioned a Trophy and Medals from Core Climbing Holds; the Trophy will be engraved with the winning walls name each year and held for twelve months.

Invites to the event will be sent out soon to all regional climbing centres.

#### 2024 Rock Solid Bouldering series.

Planning is well underway for next year's Bouldering series; we are currently organising venues for the four rounds which start in June. We would like to thank all the Northeast climbing walls who have really embraced this event and helped us make it the success it is. We are extremely grateful for all their support and wish everyone a successful 2024 season.
